Prizes: All prizes will be in kind and presented at the annual presentation evening.

To enter a competition

1. Unless there is a stated closing date for entries, book a tee time for the competition day that you are going to play. After your name type a (C) to show you are entering the competition. If there is a stated closing date, you must confirm your intention to enter by emailing Richard Hines richjohnhines@yahoo.co.uk by that date. Richard will reserve the appropriate number of tee slots and confirm your tee-time.
2. Download a scorecard from the Club website or collect a scorecard from the Club – kept in the black cupboard just outside the players entrance.
3. A £2.00 entry fee per player will be required (with the exception of the initial free competitions). Before starting your round, put your entry fee in an envelope (you can either use your own or one from the black cupboard) endorsed with your name and the date. Place it in the post box on the outside Clubhouse wall.

Completing the scorecard

1. Write your name in **Player A** and your partner's name in **Player B** on the scorecard
2. In the Competition box, enter the name of the competition (Medal, Stableford or the name of the trophy).
3. Enter your name and the date of play on your scorecard
4. Put your current handicap in the Handicap box (If you do not have a Handicap leave the Handicap box blank).
5. **DO NOT EXCHANGE SCORECARDS**
6. Regardless of the format you are playing, in a singles competition, record the **number of strokes** taken for each hole in the column **Score A** and your partner's strokes in the column **Markers Score**.
In a pairs competition, one of the pair is Player A and the other is player B. If player A's score is taken, then that score is entered in column Score A and similarly for Player B if their score is taken. Record the opponents best score in the column Markers Score.
7. At the end of your round, total up your score and check this hole by hole with your playing partner.
8. When you have both agreed your scores, you must sign YOUR OWN card in the players **Signature Box** and record you partners name in the **Markers box**.
9. All scorecards must then be placed in the clubhouse post box - **when approaching the post box, you must observe social distancing if anyone is approaching the first tee.**

Please note that, if you do not have a competition handicap, whilst you can play in a competition, you cannot win it. To gain a competition handicap, you must submit three competition cards - this can be achieved by playing in the first three events in the revised fixture list.

ADDITIONAL TEMPORARY LOCAL RULES FOR CLUB COMPETITIONS DURING COVID-19 - Effective 3 July 2020 until further notice

Playing

Flag sticks **MUST NOT** be removed at any time.

You are reminded that, if there is any chance your ball might not be found or is possibly out of bounds, you must declare and play a provisional ball under Rule 18.

The mole drain slits are Abnormal Course Conditions and free relief may be taken as Ground Under Repair.

Bunkers

Bunkers must not be smoothed before playing a bunker shot. However, a player may take a preferred lie. The player must mark the ball position and may place the ball within 6 inches of the marker but not nearer the hole.

After playing your bunker shot, you should attempt to smooth over the area with your feet and/or club.
